

Bone and Stone – Echoes of the Past Exhibit and Study on a CD

In 1856 the remains of a highly developed humanoid were discovered in the Neander Valley in Germany, later to be named the Neanderthal Man. Mr. Adams traces the story of the Neanderthal sub-species, its behaviour and material culture and reviews the development of the historic research.

The CD is in fact a digital version of a sixteen page (one frame) philatelic exhibit. Browsing through the pages is convenient and user friendly and the contents are fascinating even to non-collectors.

Mr. Adams exhibited the CD in the “Jerusalem 2006” exhibition in the Literature class and won a Large Vermeil medal.
